Transportation

The following is a list that should help with getting to Eugene, and around the area, once you're here.

The local bus system (Land Transit District or LTD) is very good and dependable. The other nice thing about Eugene is the ease with which folks can get around on their own two feet or bike. Good luck!

Note: The Greyhound Station is 2 blocks east and 2 blocks north of the City Bus Station. A ticket to ride the LTD is \$1.50 and \$3.00 for a day pass. The best thing to do is grab a bus schedule from the bus station once you arrive. Schedules can and do change. Also remember that most out of town buses run only Monday through Friday.

Bus #27 will get you from the LTD Eugene station, on the corner of Willamette and 11th, directly to NYC headquarters at 2621 Augusta St in about 25 minutes.

Motel/Hotels

Cost: \$43-49 (\$5 extra per person over 2)

Description: The Timbers is very convenient as

Franklin Inn & The Travel Lodge

Cost: Starts at \$ 55.95 (summer rates)

Description: Located about 2 miles from NYC headquarters, this motel has all the amenities: pool, cable, phones etc.

66 Motel & Manor Motel

Cost: \$ 40.83 one person single, \$ 49.67 two person double

Description: Located about 2.5 miles from NYC headquarters. Good deal, especially with sharing expenses.

Downtown Motel

Campgrounds

Fern Ridge Reservoir, Richardson Park Campground

(541)-935-2005 Season from Mid April through mid-October

Located near Veneta off of Hwy. 126 (approx. 15 miles west of Eugene).

Cost: starts at \$16/night for developed campsites. \$5 per extra vehicle.

Note: Bus #93 from the city station will take you out here.

There is however high RV use, but it is relatively close to the city.

Located 27 miles east of Eugene off of Hwy. 58

Cost: Between \$7 and \$11/night for primitive sites.

Note: City Bus #92 travels this direction. Said to be a favorite for locals and beautiful.

A few local places to eat

Breakfast

Keystone Café corner W.5th & Lawrence

Kind vegan and veggie hippie food! Actually, they do offer turkey in some dishes. This place has great food, reasonable prices, and slow service. It's a great place if you're not in a hurry. They don't take credit cards.

Brails 1689 Willamette You want classic breakfast? You got it. Greasy food, veggie options, big portions and an overly-excited server. (you'll see what I mean). Decent prices.

Lunch, Dinner, Pizza, Pubs...

Burrito Boy 510 East Broadway, 943 River Road, Franklin Blvd near motel 66

Cheap, easy and fast, Burrito Boy serves up hearty portions for a south of the border breakfast, lunch or dinner. A variety of vegetarian and vegan options are available. Open 24 hours.

Las Brasas Taqueria 541 Blair Blvd

Great food, good price, take out or dine in, no cards. Faster service if you speak Spanish. Caspian 13th Street near Campus (U of O) Mediterranean and Mexican for a good deal. \$4-6. Portions are pretty big.

Cornucopia Market and Deli 295 West 17th Avenue

Fresh sliced meats and cheeses and homemade soups and salads keep the tables constantly full. Meals range from \$5 to \$10.

High Street Café 1243 High St

Wide variety of burgers, pastas, salads and vegetarian meals. They have a great outdoor area.

Meals from \$5-\$10.

The Jail 490 E. Broadway (next to Burrito Boy on Franklin close to Motel 66)

BBQ and teriyaki joint. Police officers and fire department frequent this place, as well. Huge portions! 11 am-11 pm Monday through Saturday. Some cards. Cheap.

Pizza Research Institute 1328 Lawrence Street

Locally owned- huge pizzas with organic ingredients. Regular and vegan chef special pies change daily. Interesting ingredients from peaches and pears to asparagus and a variety of cheeses. Very small seating area, so be willing to wait or take it to go. Pies range from \$18 to \$25, and slices are available for a few bucks.

Pizza Pipeline downtown on Charnelton St

Seven days a week, before 4pm, you can get 3 slices of pizza and a large drink for \$3.00.

Cozmic Pizza 1432 Willamette St

Cool atmosphere including music, high ceilings, good food, and options to sit at internet while you wait.

Pegasus Smokehouse Pizza 790 E 14th Ave

it's not cheap, but they have great pizza including barbeque chicken pizza, Mediterranean, and a VEGGIE VORTEX. It's a cool and laid back atmosphere.

Eugene Public Library 100 West 10th Ave. Free to the public but unless you have a library card, you have to wait and can only use it for 15 minutes at a time (they only have 2 available computers for the public without cards)

University of Oregon Library- On campus in the library building downstairs there are a large number of computers with pretty flexible time limits. Also free.
